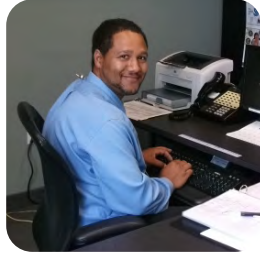




## FEATURED ALUMNI
