Multimedia activities: participants will explore French in entertaining ways and practice their oral skills through websites specializing in language acquisition.

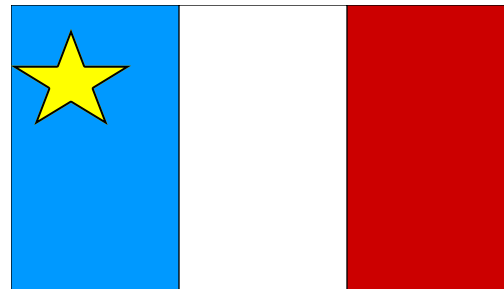


Others: Sports, dance, BBQ's, films, games, fieldtrips

The first 12 applicants will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.

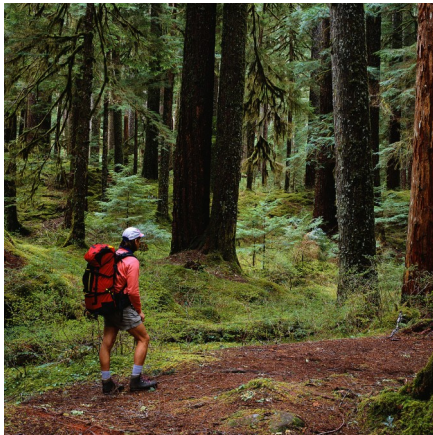
