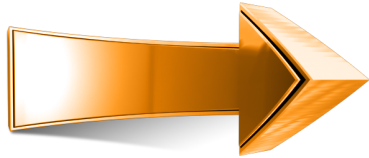

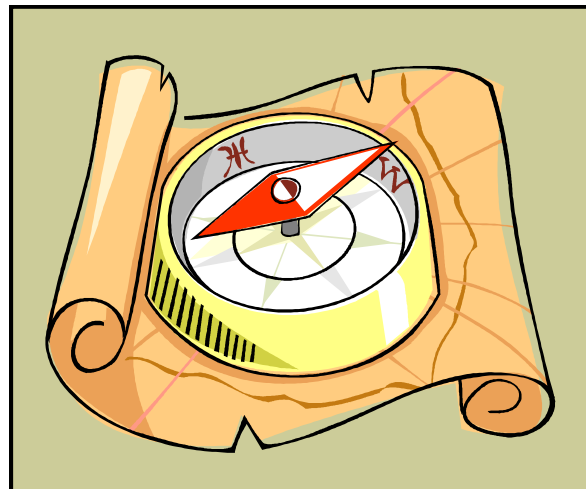
Expenses & Costs

Course Work

MATH SKILL DEVELOPMENT

This course will help to increase skills in areas of mathematical deficiencies. Class will be personalized and developed on a case by case basis. Topics to be covered will include whole numbers, integers, decimals, fractions, percents, geometry and problem solving. (2 credits)

COLLEGE WRITING

This course will focus on the basic skills needed to be a successful writer in college including: the writing cycle, expectations, citation rules, drafting, revising, grammar, punctuation, and mechanics. (2 credits)

COLLEGE READING

Reading is a core component of all collegiate work. This course addresses reading by providing skills and techniques for organizing and comprehending assignments and utilizing students' knowledge in order to be successful in college coursework. (2 credits)

ACADEMIC SUCCESS SEMINAR

This course will cover topics to ensure college success such as: Note Taking, Study Skills, Time Management, Test Anxiety, Stress Management, Career Planning, Information Literacy, Computer Competency, etc. (1 credit)
