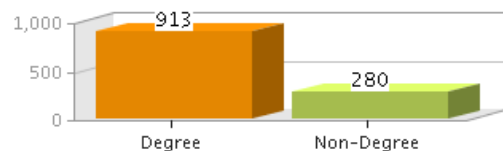

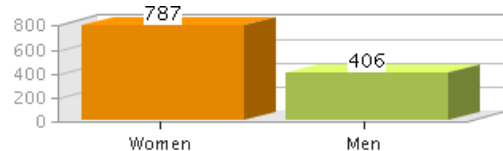

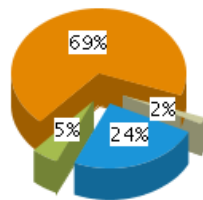

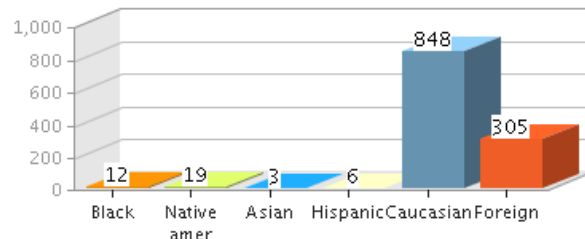

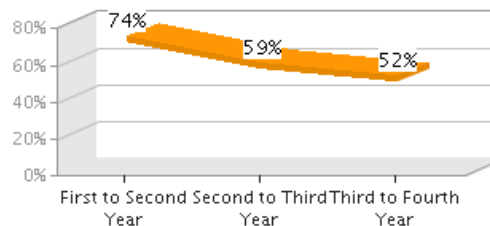

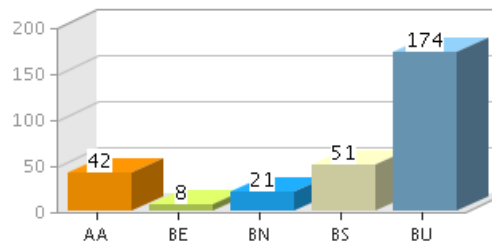

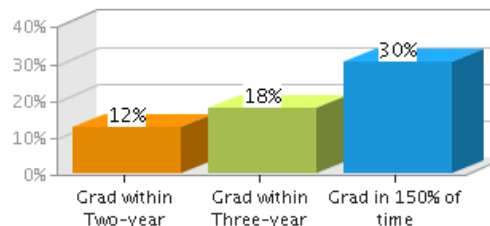
#### Retention Rates - New First Time (5 years average)



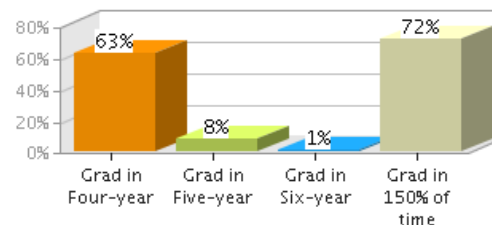
#### Most Recent Graduates



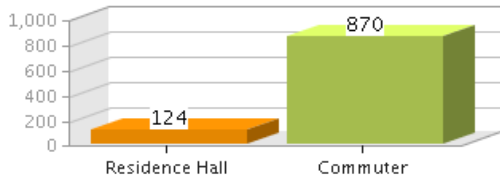
#### Graduation Rates - 2 years (5 years average)



#### Graduation Rates - 4 years (5 years average)

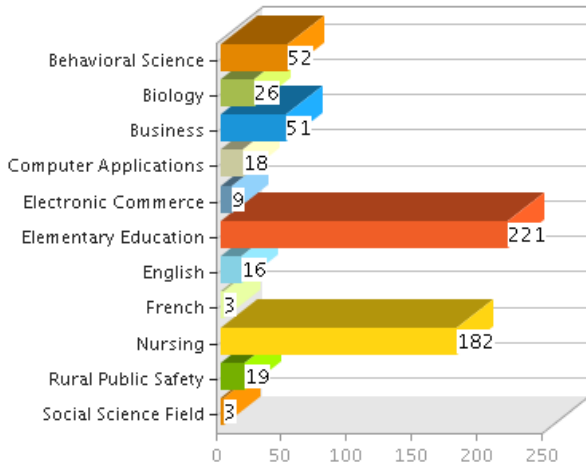
