As the work of the UMFK presidential search committee concludes, I want to take this opportunity to thank everyone for the warm welcome and the hospitality extended to our presidential finalists in February. The candidates expressed their appreciation for the work of the committee, the campus and the community members in hosting these campus visits.

I also want to thank those who took the time to complete the confidential surveys administered by our search consultant firm, Storbeck Search. The committee and the Chancellor received the anonymous data late last week and have reviewed it carefully. The search committee met this past Wednesday to debrief the candidate visits and the feedback surveys. The committee will conclude their work with a final meeting with Chancellor Malloy during his time on campus next week. The Chancellor will then conduct further due diligence and will make his selection and recommendation to the Board of Trustees in the coming weeks. A public announcement of the new president will follow shortly thereafter.
