Complete the Residence Hall Questionnaire and Dining Contract

Purchase Your Books After You've Registered for Classes

All books are ordered at our UMFK online bookstore located at campusstore.umfk.edu. You can choose to rent or purchase new or used books, or even download e-books. In order to purchase books, you must be registered for classes. Students are encouraged to order books at least 2 weeks prior to the start of the semester.

Complete the Required Immunization Forms & Medical Forms

All students enrolled in an on-campus program are required to show proof of immunization as well as provide basic medical information. Student Health Insurance
